### **Special Conditions Explanation:**

- Traffic control- We will not block thru traffic or access to any resident. The intent is to construct one half width of roadway at a time. Contractor must provide proper signage, and flag personnel at all times. Should Police Officer be necessary, Jacinto City Police Officers must be used. No exceptions.
- 2. All driveways must be sawcut before concrete demolition for proper final fit to new concrete road. This is incidental to concrete replacement.
- 3. All concrete pavement must meet Harris County specifications and is to be paid by the square yard. A copy of the concrete tickets to be given to Jacinto City inspector daily.
