## THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF JACINTO CITY WILL MEET IN SPECIAL SESSION ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, 2021 AT 6:00 P. M. IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, 10301 MARKET STREET FOR THE PURPOSE OF A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ANTICIPATED BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2021/2022.

This proposed budget will raise more revenue from property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of \$ 156,070, which is a 4.5 percent increase from last year's budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$ 74,910.59.
