GOVERNMENT OFFICES are exempt from paying fee(s) and other costs, however the issuance of a permit is necessary for Jacinto City to be aware of the alarm site and for the proper response to alarm calls.

Five (5) false alarms (burglar and hold up/panic) are allowed without charge for each permit. Thereafter, each false is chargeable at \$50.00 per response. Each permit subject to revocation after the fifth (5th) false alarm, within the annual permit period and/or the failure to pay any fee(s) assessed.

NON-PERMITTED ALARM SITE:

Any person or entity operating an alarm site that is non-permitted is subject to a fine not exceeding \$200.00

ACCEPTABLE METHODS OF PAYMENT:

Company checks, money orders and cashier's checks are acceptable by mail or in person. Cash payments are only acceptable in person at the City Hall.

The applicant or authorized agent affirms that all information contained herein is true and correct to the best of his/her knowledge. This permit may be revoked or denied for false or misleading information. The permit may be revoked for excessive false alarms and/or non payment of fees and/or fines owed to Jacinto City in accordance with rules relating to alarm systems promulgated by the City Council of Jacinto City. The Jacinto City Police Department has rules, policies, and procedures that are not specified on this application. The purpose of these rules and regulations promulgated by The City of Jacinto City is to promote the reduction of costly false alarms in the city. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

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ALARM PERMITS AND REGULATIONS

1. Application for a permit for the operation of an alarm system shall be made by any person having control over the property on which the alarm system is to be installed and operated.
2. There is no fee for application; however, failure to obtain such permit shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined up to \$200.00 and each day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.
3. Each permit issued to the permit holder is nontransferable.
4. Five (5) false alarms (burglar and hold up/panic) are allowed without charge for each permit. Thereafter, each false is chargeable at \$50.00 per response.
5. Permits are subject to revocation after the 5th false alarm, within the annual permit period and/or the failure to pay any fee(s) assessed.
6. Application may be revoked or denied for false or misleading information.
7. Alarm information shall be submitted not earlier than twenty (20) days of installation and not later than forty-eight (48) hours.
8. Each alarm system business shall notify in writing of any change of the licensed manager for the business within forty-eight (48) hours after such change and of change in telephone number by which personnel can be reached prior to such change.

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
