What to do Right Away :

▶ 1. Call the Companies where you know the fraud occurred.

2.Place a fraud alert with a credit reporting agency.

▶ 3. **Report Identity theft** to the Federal Trade Commission (FTC).

▶ 4. File a report with your local police department.
