## LITTLE LEAGUE CONSTITUTION (SAMPLE)

## ARTICLEI-NAME

This organization shall be known as the $\qquad$ Luthe League, hereinater referred to as "Local League."

## ARTICLE II - OBJECTIVE

## SECTION 1

The oblective of the Local League shall be to implant firmly in the children of the community the ideals of good sportsmanship, honesty, loyafty, courage and respect for authority, so that they may be well adjusted, stronger and happier children and will grow to be good, decant, healthy and trustworthy citizens.

## SECTION 2

To achieve this objective, the Local League will provide a supervised program under the Rules and Regutations of Little Leagua Baseball, Incorporated. All Directors, Officers and Members shall bear in mind that the attainment of exceptional athetic skill or the winning of games is secondary, and the molding of future citizens is of prime importance, In accordance with Section 501 -(c)(3) of the Federal Internal Revenue Code, the Local League shall operale exchusively as a non-proft educational organization providing a supervised program of compatilive baseball and softball games. No part of the net earnings shall inure to the benafit of any private shareholder or individual; no substantial part of the activities of which is carrying on propaganda, or othenwise attempting to influence legislation. and which does no: participate in or intervene in any polltical campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

## ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

## SECTION 1

Ellgibility - Any person sincerely interested in active participation to further the objective of this Local League may apply to become a Member.

## SECTION 2

Classes - There shal be the following classes of Members:
(a) Player Members - Any player candidate meeting the requirements of Litile League Regulation IV shall be ellgible to compete for

Note: Regular Members of the league aulomatically include all current Managers, Coaches, Vounteer Umpires, Board Members, Officars of the Board, and any other person who is recognized by the Board as a volunteer in the Local League, including the tollowing volunteers tities listed below.
Recommend Positions: Team parent, Equipment Manager, Coaching Coordinator, Sponsorship/Fundraisers Manager, Information Otticer, Groundskeepers, Concessions Manager, Umpire-In-Chlel etc...

Honorary Members (Optional) - Any person may be elected as Honorary Member by the unanimous vole of all Directors present at any duly held meeting of the Board of Directors buh shall have no rights, dulles op obligations in the menagement or in the property of the Local League.
(c) Sustaining Members (Optional) - Any person not a Regular Member who makes financial or other contribution to the Local League may by a majority vole of the Board of Directors become a Sustaining Member, but such person shall have no rights, duttes or obligations in the management or in the property of the Local League.
(d) As used hereinatter, the word "Member" shall mean a Regular Nember unless otherwise steled.

## SECTION 3

## Other Awitantons:

(a) Members, whether Regutar or Player, shall not be required to be aftilialed with another organization or group to quality as members of the Local Leagus.
(b) Regular Members should not be actively engaged in the promotion andfor operation of any other baseball/softball program.

## SECTION 4

Suspension or Termination: Membership may be lerminated by resignation or action of the Board of Directors as follows.
(a) The Board of Directors, by a two-thirds vote of those present at any duly constituted Board meeting, shall have the authority to discipline or suspend or terminate the membership of any Member of any class, including managers and coaches, when the conduct of such person is considered detrimental to the best interests of the Local League andior Litte League Baseball, Incorporated. The Member involved shall be notified of such meeting, informed of the general nature of the charges and given an opportunity to appear at the meeting to answer such charges.
(b) The Board of Directors shall, in case of a Player Member, give notice to the manager of the team for which the player is a Player Member. Said manager shall appear, in the capacily of an adviser, with the player before the Board of Directors or a duly appointed committee of the Board of Directors. The player's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) may also be present. The Board of Directors shall have full power to suspend or revoke such player's right to future participation by two-thirds vole of those present at any duly constituted meeting (quorum is required).

## ARTICLE IV - DUES FOR REGULAR MEMBERS (NOT PLAYERS)

## SECTION 1

Dues for Regutar Members may be fixed at such amounts as the Board of Directors shall detemine for a particular fiscal year. (See Article XI, Section 7 lor fiscal year of this league.) Note: Dues for Regular Members are separate from registration fees tor Player Mernbers, which are determined annualy by the Board of Directors in accordance with Regulation XIII (c). II no dues for Regular Membership are collected, Section 2 below does not apply.

## SECTION 2

## ARTICLE V - GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS

## SECTION 1

Definition: A General Membership Meeting is any meating of the membership of the league (including Special General Membership Meetings, Section 7). A minimum of one per year (Anrual Meeting, see Section 6) is requlred.

## SECTION 2

Notice of Menting: Notice of aach General Membership Meeting shall be delivered personally, electronically, or by mail to each Member at the last recorded address (choose one) - Ien (10) $\qquad$ lourteen (14) $\qquad$ twenty one (21). in advance of the meeting. setting forth the place, time and purpose of the meeting.

## SECTION 3

Quorum: At eny General Mumberstip Meating, the presence in person or representation by absenlee ballot of (choose one)... © one third ( 33.3 percent) C one fourth ( 25 percent) $\cap$ one fifth ( 20 percent) .n. of the members (as delined in Articte Ifl - Membership) shall be necessary to constitute a quorum. Il a quorum is not present, no business shall be conducted.

## SECTION 4

Voting: Onty Regular Members in good standing shall be entited to make motions and vole at General Membership Meetings. However, the Board of Directors may invite, admit and recognize guests for presentations or cornments during General Membership Meetings. (Those eligible to take part at meetings of the Board of Directors are described in Articie VI. Section 4.)

## SECTION 5


#### Abstract

Absentee Ballot: For the expressed purpose of accommodating a Regular Member in good standing who cannol be in attendance at the Annual Meeting, or any General Membership Meeting at which new Board members will be elected, an absentee ballot may be requested and obtained from the Secretary of the League. The absentee ballot shall be properly compleled, signed and returned in a sealed envelope to the Secretary prior to the date of the election. The Secretary shall present all absentee ballots to the Election Chairman (eppointed al the meeting) on the date of the meeting, prior to the voling portion of the election process.


## SECTION 6

Annual Meeting of the Members: The Annual Meeting of the Members of the Local League shall be held (Insert dalefime) First Fridav of August@7:00 om. $\qquad$ (For example: "the third Wednesday ol (month) al 8 p.m.") each year for the purpose ol electing new Members, electing the Board of Diractors, receiving reparts, reviewing the Constitution, appointing committeas, and for the transaction of such business as may properly come before the meating.
(a) The Membership shall receive at the Annual Meeting of the Members of the Local League a report, veriled by the President and Treasurer, or by a majority of the Directors, showing:
(1) The condition of the Local League, to be presented by the President or hishel designate;
(2) A general summary of funds received and expended by the local league for the previous year, the amount of funds currenlly in possession of the local league, and the name of the financial institution in which such funds are maintained;
(3) The whole amount of real and personal property owned by the Local League, where localed, and where and how invested;
(4) For the year inmediately precading, the amount and nature of the property acquired, with the date of the report and the manner of the acpuisition, the amount applied, appropriated or expended, and the purposes, objects or persons to or for which such applications, appropriations or expenditures have been made.
(5) The names of the persons who have been admitted to reguiar membership in the Local League during such year. This report shall be filed with the records of the Local League and entered in the minutes of the proceedings of the Annual Meeting. A copy of such report shall be lorwarded to Littie Leagua International.
(b) At the Annual Meeting, the Members shall determine the number of Directors to be elected for the ensuing year and shall elect such number of Directors. The number of Directors elected shail be not less than seven (7).
(c) After the Board of Directors is elected, the Board shall meet to efect the officers. After the election, the Board of Directors shall assume the performance of its duties on 09/01 ( $\mathrm{mm} / \mathrm{dd}$ ). The Board's term of office shall continue until its successors are elected and qualitied under this section.
(d) The Officers of the Board of Directors shall include, at a minimum, the President, one or more Vice Presidents, Treasurer. Secretary, one or more Player Agents, a Safety Officer and a Coaching Coordinator Regulation 1 (b). The Board shall also include a mintimum of one manager and one volumeer umpire. Only volunteer umpires may be elected to the Board.

Special Genowal Memberahlp Meetings - Special General Membershlp Meatings of the Members may be called by the Board of Directors or by the Secretary or President at their discretion. Upon the written request of a minimum of five members, the President or Secretary shall call a Special General Membership Meeting to consider the subject specitied in the request. No business other than that specitied in the notice of the meeting shall be transacted at any Special General Membership Meeting. Such Special General Membership Meeting shail be scheduled to take place not less than (choose one)... - five (5) __ ten (10) __ fourteen (14) __ iwenty one (21) thirty (30) ... days after the request is received by the President or Secretary.

SECTION 8
Rules of Ondep for General Memberahip Meetings and Regular Meetings of the Board of Directors - Robert's Rules of Order shall govem the proceedings of General Membership meetings. and all regular meetings of the Board of Directors, except where same conflicts with this Constitution of the Local League.

## ARTICLE VI - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

## SECTION 1

Autherity: The management of the property and affairs of the Local League shall be vested in the Board of Directors.

## SECTION 2

Increase in number: The number of Board of Directors so fixed at the Annual Meeling may be increased at any General Membership Meeting or Special Meeting of the Members. II the number is increased, the additional Directors may be elected at the meeling al which the increase is voled, or at any subsequent General Membership Meeting. All elections of additional Directors shall be by majority vote of all Regular Members present or represented by a properly executed and signed absentee ballot filed with the Secrelary prior to the election meeting.

## SECTION 3

Vacancies: If any vacancy occurs in the Board of Directors, by death, resignation or pherwise, il may be filled by a majority vote of the remaining Directors at any regular Board meating or al any Special Board Meeting called for that purpose

## SECTION 4

Board Meetings, Notice and Quorum: Regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held immediately following the Annual Meeting and on such days thereatter as shall be determined by the Board.
(a) The President or the Secretary may, whenever they deem it advisable, or the Secretary shall at the request in writing of 5 . Directors, issue a call for a Special Board Meeting. In the case of Special Board Mealings, such notice shall include the purpose of the meeting and no matters not so stated may be acted upon at the meeting.
(b) Notice of each Board meeting shall be given by the Secretary personally, electronically of by mall to each Director at least 5 day(3) before the time appointed for the meeting to the last recorded address of each Director.
(c) $2 / 3$ Members of the Board of Directors shall constilute a quorum for the transaction of business. If a quorum is not present, no business shall be conducted.
(d) Only members of the Board of Directors may make motions and vole at meatings of the Board of Direclors. However, the Board of Directors may invite, admit and recognize guests for presentations or comments during Board maetings.

## SECTION 5

Duties and Powers: The Board of Directors shall have the power to appoint such standing committees as it shall determine appropriate and to delegale such powers to them as the Board shall deem advisable and which it may properly delegate.

The Board may adopt such rules and regulations for the conduct of its meetings and the management of the Local League as it may deem proper, provided such rules and regulations do not conflict with this Conslitution.

The Board shall have the power by a two-thirds vote of those present at any regular Board or Special Board Meeting to discipline, suspend or remove any Director or Officer or Comnittee Member of the Local League in accordance with the procedure set forth in Article III, Section 4 (a, b).

## SECTION 6

Rules of Order for Board Maetings: Robert's Rules of Order shall govern the proceedings of all ieague meetings, including Board of Directors meetings, except where same conflicts with this Constitution of the Local Leegue.

## ARTICLE VII - DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE BOARD

## SECTION 1


#### Abstract

Appolntments - The Board of Directors may appoint such other officers or agents as it may deem necessary of desirable, and may prescribe the powers and duties of each. Appointed officers or agents shall have no vole on actions taken by the Board of Drectors unless such Individuals have been elected to the Board by the membership or have been elected to fill a vacancy on the Board.


## SECTION 2

## Prosident - The President shail

(a) Conduct the attairs of the Local League and execute the policies established by the Board of Directors,
(b) Present a report of the condition of the Local League at the Annual Meating.
(c) Communicate to the Board of Directors such matters as deemed appropriate, and make such suggestions as may fend to promote the welfare of the Local League
(d) Be responsible for the conduct of the Local League in strict conformity to the policies, principles, Rules and Regulations of Little Laague Baseball, incorporated, as agreed to under the conditions of charter issued to the Local League by that organization.
(e) Designate in writing other oflicers, if necessary, to have power to make and execute forland in the name of the Local League such contracts and leases they may receive and which have had prior approval of the Board.
(i) Invesligate complaints, irregularities and conditions detrimental to the Local League and report thereon to the Board or Executive Cominittee as clrcumstances warrant.
(g) Prepare and submit an annual budget to the Board of Directors and be responsible for the proper execution thereol.
(h) With the assistance of the Player Agent, examine the application and support proof-of age documents of every player candidate and cerify to residence or school enrollment, and age eligibility belore the player may be accepted for fryouts and sefection
(i) Complete the required background checks per Little League Regulation I (b) and I (c) B \& 9 ; or delegate this resporisiblity to the league's Salety Officer, or other designated Board member.

## SECTION 3

Vice President - The Vice President shalit
(a) Perform the duties of the President in the absence or disability of the President, provided he or she is authorlzed by the President or Board so to act. When so acting, the Vice President shall have all the powers of that office.
(b) Periorm such duties as from time to time may be assigned by the Board of Directors or by the President.

Secretary - The Secretary shall:
(a) Be responsible for recording the activities of the Local League and maintain appropriate files, mailing lists and necessary records.
(b) Periorm such duties as are herein specifically set forth, in addition to such other duties as are customarily incidenl to the affice of Secretary or as may be assigned by the Board of Directors
(c) Mainlain a list of all Regular, Sustaining and Honorary Members, Directors and committee members and give notice of all meetings of the Local Lasgue, the Board of Directors and Committees.
(d) Issue membership cards to Regular Mernbers, if approved by the Board of Directors.
(e) Keep the minutes of the moatings of the Members, the Board of Directors and the Execinive Committee, and cause them to be recorded in a book kept for thal purpose.
(i) Conduct all correspondence not otherwise specifically delegated in connection with said meeting and shall be responsible for carrying out all orders, votes and resolutions not otherwise committed.
(g) Nolify Mernbers, Divectors. Officers and committee members of their election or appointment.

## SECTION 5

Treasurer - The Treasurer shall:
(a) Perform such duties as are herein set lorth and such other duties as are customarily incident to the Ollice of Treasurer or may be assigned by the Board of Directors.
(b) Receive all moneys and securties, and deposit same in a depository approved by the Board of Directors.
(c) Keep records for the recsipt and disbursement of all monays and securities of the Locad League, inchuding the Auxllary, approve aft payments from allatted funds and draw checks therelore in agreement with policies established in advance of such actions by the Board of Directors. All disbursements by check must have dual signatures.
(d) Prepare an annual budget, under the direction of the President, for submission to the Board ol Directors at the Annual Meating.
(e) Prepare an annual linancial report, under the direction of the President, for submission to the Membership and Board of Directors at the Annual Meeting, and to Little League International.

## SECTION 6

Player Agent - The Piayer Agent shall:
(a) Record all player transactions and maintain an accurate and up-to-date record thereof.
(b) Receive and review applications for player candidates and assist the President in verifying residence or school envollment and age eligibility.
(c) Conduct the tryouts, the player draft and all other player transaction or sefection meetings.
(d) Prepare the Player Agent's list.
(e) Prepare for the President's signature and submission to Little League international, team rosters, including players ctaimed, and the toumament team eligibility atfidavit.
(I) Notity Little League International of any subsequent player replacements or trades.

## SECTION 7

## safaty Owloar - The Saldy Ollicer shall

(a) Be responsible to create awareness, through education and information, of the opportunities to provide a safer environmant for chlidren and all participants of Litte League.
(b) Develop and implement a plan for increasing satety of activities, equipment and facithies through education, compliance and reporting.
NOTE: In order to implament a safety plan using education, compliance and raporting, the following suggestions may be utilized by the Sately Officer:
(1) Education - Should facilitete meatings and distribute information annong participants including players, managers, coachas, umpires, league officiels, parents. guardians and other volunteers.
(2) Compliance - Should promote safety compliance leadership by increasing awareness of the safety opportunities that arise from these responsibilities.
(3) Reporting - Define a process to assure that incidents are recordad, information is sent lo league/district and national offices, and follow-up information on medical and other data is forwarded as avallable.
(4) Beckground Checks - If the League President so designates, the satety officer will complete the required background checks per Litte League Regulation I (b) and I (c) 8 \& 9.

## SECTION 8

## Caaching Coordinator - The coaching coordinator shall

(a) Represent coaches/managers in league:
(b) Present a coesch/manager training buiget to the board.
(c) Gain the support and funds necessary 10 implement a league-wide training program:
(d) Order and distribute training materials to players, coaches and managers;
(e) Ccordinate mini-clinics as necessary;
(I) Serve as the contact person for Little League international.

## SECTION 9

## League Information Onicer - The Lasgue information Officer shall:

(a) Set up and manage the league's olficial website (sile authorized by Litio League intemational);
(b) Sel up online registration and ensure player, manager, and coach data is uploaded to the Litle Leegue Data Center;
(c) Assign online administrative rights to other local voluntaers:
(d) Encourage creation of tean web sites to managers, coaches, and parents;
(a) Ensure that league nows and scores are updated online on a regular basis;
(n) Collect post, and distribute important informetion on laague activities including direct diasemination of fund-ralsing and sponsor activities. the district, the public, league members, and the madia
(g) Serves as primary contact person for Litte League regarding optimizing use of the internet for league administration and for distributing information to leagua members and to Little Leagua Basebali, incorporated

Marketing/Public Relations Manager - The Marketing/Public Relations Manager shall
(a) Oversee new player recruitment eflorts;
(b) Develop and maintain a league marketing plan focused on player recruitment and retention;
(c) Oversee eflorts to market new divisions of play and intiatives offered by the league;
(d) Work with local media to promote the interests of Little League;
(e) Coordinate efforts to make the local league visibla in the community year-round

## SECTION 11

Sponzorship/Fundralsing Manager - The Sponsorship/Fundraising Manager shall.
(a) Solicit and secures tocal sponsorships to support league operations.
(b) Collect and reviews sponsorship and fundraising opportunittes:
(c) Organize and implements approved laague fundraising activities;
(d) Coordinate participation in fundraising activties;
(e) Meintain records of monies secured through sponsorship and fundraising initiatives.
(f) Ensure regulation and polices related to sponsorships and fundraising are followed.

## SECTION 12

Concesston Manager - The Concession Manager shall:
(a) Maintain the operation of concession lackities,
(b) Organize the purchase of concession products;
(c) Be responstble for the management of the concession sales at league events,
(d) Schedules volunteers to work the concession booth during leagua events;
(e) Collects and reviews concession-related offers, inchuding discounts and bulk-purchasing opportunities.
(i) Organize, tally, and keep records of concession sales and purchases

## SECTION 13

## Umplre-In-Chief - The Umplre-in-Chief (U.I.C) shall:

(a) Serve as coordinator of the local leagur umpire program
(b) Advise the League President on the local league umplre program
(c) Recommend volunteer umpires to League President to serve the league during the regular season.
(d) Recruit, review, and retain volunteer umpires
(e) Establish and implement an umpire training program for volunteer umpires consistent with Little Leaguee guidelines
(f) Communicate rule changes to league volunteer umpires, managers, and coachas
(g) Recormmend toumamen-worthy umpires to the District Umpire Consultant
(h) Attend umpire training programs at the district, state, and region levels

## ARTICLE VIII - EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

No local league is required to appoint Board members to Committees or use this tool of operation to manage the local league. However, the committee structure is recommended to engage the Board of Directors, assist with efficienthy delagating responsibilites throughout the year, and provide oversite in the operation of the local league.

## SECTION 1

The Board of Directors may appoint an Executive Committee which shall consist of not less than three (3) nor more than five (5) Directors, one of whom shail be the President of the Local League.

## SECTION 2

The Executlve Committee shal advise with and assist the Officers of the Local League in all matters concerning its interesis and the management of its affairs, and shall have such other powers as may be delegated to it by the Board, but in no event will the Executive Committee have authority over the Board of Directors

## SECTION 3

At any meeting of the Executive Committee, a malority of the total number of members then in office shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, and the act of a majority present at any meeting at which there is a quorum shall be the act of the Committee.

## ARTICLE IX - OTHER COMMITTEES AND BOARD POSITIONS

(Ptace an "X" on the line next to eech applicable committee)

## SECTION I

Nominating Committee: The Board of Directors may appoint a Nominating Committee consisting of three (3) Directors and other appointed Regular Members. The Committee shall investigate and consider eligible candidates and submit at the Annual Meeting a slate of candidates for the Board of Directors. The Committee shall also submit for consideration by the Board of Directors a slate of Officers and Commitee Members.

## SECTION 2

Membership Committee: The Board of Directors may appoint a Membership Committee consisting of three (3) Directors and other appoinled Regular Members. The Committee shall receive the names of prospective Honorary, Susiaining and Regular Members, investigate Ior eligllility and recommend those qualified for election at the annual, regular, or any special meeting of the Members or the Board of Directors.

## SECTION 3

Finance Committee: The Board of Directors may appoint a Finance Comnittee consisting of not less than three (3) nor more than five (5) Directors. The Treasurer shall be an ex-officio member of the Committee. The Committee shall investigate ways and means of financing the Local League including leam sponsorships and submit recommendations.

It shall be responsible for taking up collections at games, if such collections are authorized by the Local League, and shall turn over said collections to the Treasurer immedlately atter each game.

## SECTION 4

Bullding and Property Committee: (May be combined with Grounds Committee) The Board of Directors may appoint a Bulding and Property Committee consisting of three (3) Direciors and other appointed Regular Members. The Committee shall investigate and recommend avallable. suitable sites and plans for development, including ways and means, the latter in cooperation with the Finance Committee. It shall be responsible for repair and improvement recommendations, other than normal maintenance, and supervise the perlormance of approved projects.

Grounds Committee: (May be combined with Euilding and Propenty Committee) The Board of Directors may appoint a Grounds Committee which shall be responslble for the care and maintenance of the playing field(s), buildings and grounds. It shall operate within the amount appropriated in the approved budget for that purpose.

## SECTION 6

Playing Equipment Committee: The Eoard of Directors may appoint a Playing Equipment Commitee which shall secure bids on needed supplies and equipment and make recommendations for their purchase to the Board.

The Committee shall be responsible for the proper issuance of such supplies and equipment and for the repair, cleaning and storage thereol at the close of the season.

SECTION 7
Managers Committee: The Board of Drectors may appoint a Managers Committee consisting of three (3) Directors.
The Commitee shall interview and investigate prospective managers and coaches, including those for the Minor League teams and recommend acceptable candidates to the President, for appointment and subsequent approval by the Board of Directors. It shall, during the playing season, observe the conduct of the managers and coaches and report its findings to the President of the Local League. It shall, at the request of the President or Board of Directors, investigate complaints conceming managers and coaches and make a report thereof to the President or Board of Directors as the case may be.

## SECTION 8

Umpire Committee: The Board of Directors may appoint an Umplre Committee consisting of inree (3) Directors and other appointed Regular Members. The Local League President shall be chairman of any such Commlttee. The Committee shall recruit, interview and recommend to the President for appointment a stalf of umpires, including a UIC and replacements. When appointed, the staff of umpires shall be under the personal direction of the Local League President, assisted by the UIC who shall train, observe and schedule the staff.

SECTION 9
District Committee: The Board of Directors may appoint a District Cormmittee consisting of the Local League President as chairman and two $(2)$ other Directors. The Committee shall assist the District Administrator in inferleague district functions including the selection of members of the District Administratar's Advisory Committee and the selection of toumament sites and area loumament directors.

## SECTION 10

Auditing Committee: The Board of Directors may appoint an Audifing Committee consisting of three (3) Directors. The President, Treasurer or signatories of checks are not eliglble. The Committee will review the Local League's books and records annually prior to the Annual Meeting and attach a statement of its findings to the annual linancial statement of the President and Treasurer; or may, \#directed by the Board of Directors or Membership, secure the services of a Certified Public Accountant to accomplish such review.

## SECTION 11

Winor League Committee: The Board of Directors may appoint a Minor League Cormmittee consisting of three (3) Directors. The Chairman of the Committee shall be the Minor League Vice President and be responsible to the Local League President for the proper conduct of the Minor League operation.

## SECTION 12

Other Committees and Board Positlons: The Board of Directors may appoint a committee consisting of three (3) Directors. The Chairman of the Committee; or add Board positions tor the spectic purpose of fuffiling a need that is presently not addressed, of accounted lor by an existing committee

#### Abstract

Charter: The Local League shall annually apply for a charter from Little League Baseball, Incorporated, and shall do all things necessary to obtain and maintain such charter. The Local League shall devote its entire energies to the activities authorized by such charter and it shall not be affiliated with any other program or organization or operate any other program.


SECTION 2
Rulas and Regulations: The Ofliciad Playing Rules and Regulations as published by Litie League Beseball, Incorporated, Wiliamsport, Pernsytvania, shall be binding on this Local League.

## SECTION 3

Lecal Rules, Ground Fules and/or Bylaws: The local rules, ground rules and/or bylaws of this Local League shall be adopled by the Board ol Directors at a meeting to be held not less than one month previous to the first scheduled game of the season, but shall in no way conflict with the Rules, Regulations and Policies of Littla League Basebali, Incorporated, nor shall they conllict with this Constitution. The local rules, ground rules andor byaws of livis Local League shall expire at the end of each liscal year, and are nol considered part of this Constitution. (See Articie XI, Section 7 for fiscal year of this league.)

## ARTICLE XI - FINANCIAL AND ACCOUNTING

## SECTION 1


#### Abstract

Authorty: The Board of Drectors shall decide all matters pertaining to the finances of the Local League and it shall placa all income including Auxiliary funds, in a common league treasury, directing the expendifure of funds in such manner as will give no individual or team an advantage over those In competition with such individual or leam.


## SECTION 2

Contributions: The Board shall not permif the contribution of funds or properly to individual teams but shall solicit funds for the common treasury of the Local League, thereby to discourage iavoritism among teams and to endeavor to equalize the benelits of the Local League.

## SECTION 3

Solfchations: The Board shath not permit the sollcitation of funds in the name of Littie League Baseball, Incorporated unless all of the funds so ralsad be placed in the Local League traasury.

## SECTION 4

Disbursement of Funds: The Board shall nol permit the disbursement of Local League funds for other than the conduct of Little League activities in accordance with the rules, regulations, and policies of Little League Baseball, incorporated, All disbursements shall be made by check, or league credit or debit card. All checks shall be signed by the Local League Treasurer and such other officer or officers, or person or persons, as the Board of Oirectors shall determine.

## SECTION 5

Financial Tremsparency: No Board member authorized to disburse funds may be the spouse or family relative of the League President of Treasurer, or have direct access to league funds without the written permission of the chairman of the laagua's Audit Committee. The use of a league credit or debil card is permitted, given than the card is relurned to the League President. Treasurer, or Chairman of the Audit Commintee with receipt for all purchases made within three (3) days of the purchase dale

## SECTION 6

Compensation: No Director, Officer, or Member of the Local League shall receive, difectly or indirectly any salary, compensation, or emolument from the Local League for services rendered as Difector, Officer or Member.

Deponits: All moneys recaived, including sponsorship and fundraising, shall be deposited to the credit of the Local League infat Wells Fargo Bank (name of financial institution).

SECTION 8
Fiscall year: The fiscal year of the Local League shall begin on (Check one)

- October 1 and shall end on Sepiember 30.

## SECTION 9

Distribution of Property upon Dissolution: Upon dissolution of the Local League and after all outstanding debts and claims have been satisfied. the Members shall direct the remaining property of the Local League to another Federally Incorporaled entity which maintains the same objectives as set forth in Article II of this Constitution which are or may be entitied to exemption under Section 501 -(c)-(3) of the Internal Revenua Code or any future corresponding provision

## ARTICLE XII - AMENDMENTS

This Constitution may be amended, repeated or altered in whole or in part by a malority vole at any duly organized meeting of the Members provided notice of the proposed change is inchuded in the notice of such meeting
