Disaster Debris Management Monitoring

Request for Proposal (RFP)

Jacinto City is pleased to invite proposals for the provision of Disaster Debris Management services to support our recovery from DR-4781, DR-4798 and any other disaster event within the next two years.

BACKGROUND

The City of Jacinto City is currently a sub-recipient for DR-4781, DR-4798 and is seeking a debris monitoring firm to quantify the amount of vegetative debris from both events being reduced and or transported to a final disposal site. Funding is available on a 75/25 Federal / Local match.

PURPOSE OF RFP

The purpose of this Request for Proposals is to solicit proposals from qualified service providers wishing to contract with Jacinto City to provide debris monitoring services. Prior to the issuance of this RFP, Jacinto City utilized Force Labor and Equipment to collect vegetative debris from our city and transport it to our Debris Management Site located at 12202 Market Street, Houston, Texas 77015. There are distinct debris piles for each of the two storms.

DR-4871 approximately 4000 cubic yards

DR-4798 approximately 2000 cubic yards

The RFP seeks proposals to monitor the reduction of the volume of stored vegetative debris and its transportation to a final disposal site. This work shall be conducted in a manner that can be invoiced for each of the two approved PA projects. There will be a 30-day period of performance which may be extended if requested based upon reasonable justification.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

Applicants must comply with current guidance found in the most recent FEMA Public Assistance Program and Policy Guide (PAPPG) as well as local, state and federal laws. Applicants must be registered and in good standing on the SAM system.

PRICING METHODOLOGY

Proposal prices shall be either lump sum or unit prices.

BOND

No bond is required with this Request for Proposal.

PROPOSAL SCORING CRITERIA

Experience	30 Points
Ability to perform SOW in a timely manner	30 Points
Pricing	40 Points
TOTAL	100 Points

REPORTING PROCESS

As the sub-recipient, Jacinto City requires the successful bidder to provide FEMA compliant documentation for all materials processed, transported and or disposed of. This includes daily reports, invoices and other relevant records. Weekly billing is preferred.
