We will have to cut some projects because the bids came in too high at \$265,430.00, which is over budget, After speaking with Public Works Director Thomas to discuss priorities, We knew that the council's number one priority is the parking lot by the pool so we wanted to make sure we left that one in so the three we are suggesting to take out are the City Hall lot parking lot, the Palestine project and the small section of Oswego. That removes \$83,895.00 from the project giving it a total of \$181,535.00 it's still \$21,012.00 over. Our suggestion, we spoke with councilmember Mario during the day, he couldn't make it tonight but he's in agreement to axe those three projects and ask council to amend for \$21,012.00 and do the rest of the project.
