RESOLUTION 2026-13R

Application Filing and Authorized Representative Resolution

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACINTO CITY, TEXAS, REQUESTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM THE TEXAS WATER DEVELOPMENT BOARD; AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR ASSISTANCE; AND MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACINTO CITY, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1: That an application is hereby approved and authorized to be filed with the Texas Water Development Board seeking financial assistance in an amount not to exceed \$10,000,000 to provide for the costs of replacement of waterlines.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor and the City Manager of Jacinto City, be and are hereby designated the authorized representative of the City of Jacinto City for purposes of furnishing such information and executing such documents as may be required in connection with the preparation and filing of such application for financial assistance and the rules of the Texas Water Development Board.
