<p align="center">STATE ELECTION CODE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR PUBLIC OFFICE</p>	<p align="center">CITY OF JACINTO CITY, TEXAS CHARTER ARTICLE III, QUALIFICATIONS FOR CITY COUNCIL AND THE MAYOR <small>(In addition to any other qualifications prescribed by law, the Mayor and each Councilmember must meet the following qualifications)</small></p>
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Must be a United States Citizen. 2. Must be 18 years of age or older on the first day of the term to be filled at the election or on the date of appointment, as applicable. 3. Have not been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be totally mentally incapacitated; or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote. 4. Have not been finally convicted of a felony from which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities. 5. Have resided continuously in the state for 12 months and in the territory from which the office is elected for six months immediately preceding the date of the regular filing deadline for a candidate's application for a place on the ballot. 6. On the date described by section (5), be registered to vote in the territory from which the office is elected. 7. Satisfy any other eligibility requirements prescribed by law for the office. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. He or She shall and must be citizens of the United States of America and a qualified voter of the State of Texas. 2. He or She shall be at least twenty-one (21) years of age. 3. He or She shall have resided for at least twelve (12) months next preceding the election at which he or she is a candidate within the corporate limits of the city. 4. He or She shall not be in arrears in the payment of any taxes or other liabilities due the city. 5. No employee or appointed official of the City Shall continue in such position after becoming a candidate for an elective office.
